Places near the coast have a moderate climate. It is neither too hot nor too cold here. This is due to the effect of sea breezes. Water bodies heat up and cool down at a slower rate than land. In summer therefore, the sea is cooler than the land. Hence air over the sea is cooler than that over the land. This cool air called sea breeze, blows from sea to land, making the land cooler. In winter the opposite happens and the land becomes warmer .

Places far away from the sea do not get sea breezes. So they are extremely hot in summer and very cold in winter . Such a climate is called extreme climate.
