7. The different 3-digit numbers which can be formed by using the digits 0, 2, 5 without repeating any digit in the number are 205, 250, 502 and 520.

Therefore, four 3 digit numbers can be formed by using the digits 0, 2, 5.

9. Expression $13(4 + 11) = 13 \times 15 = 195$

On reversing the answer = 591

Adding reversing number to the result i.e. $591 + 195 = 786$

Multiplying it by 13 i.e. $786 \times$

$13 = 10218.$
