Planes or rockets spray special substances into clouds.

These substances help tiny water droplets or ice crystals form.

The droplets join together and fall as rain.

It is used—

To get more water for farming, drinking, and storing.

To fight droughts by increasing rainfall.

To clean the air, as rain removes dust and pollution.

To prevent wildfires by keeping the land moist.




### Mixing Magic: Primary to Secondary Colours

### Kindness in Action: Pass the Compliment Activity






