The event ended with students promising to learn and respect the valuable knowledge of elders.



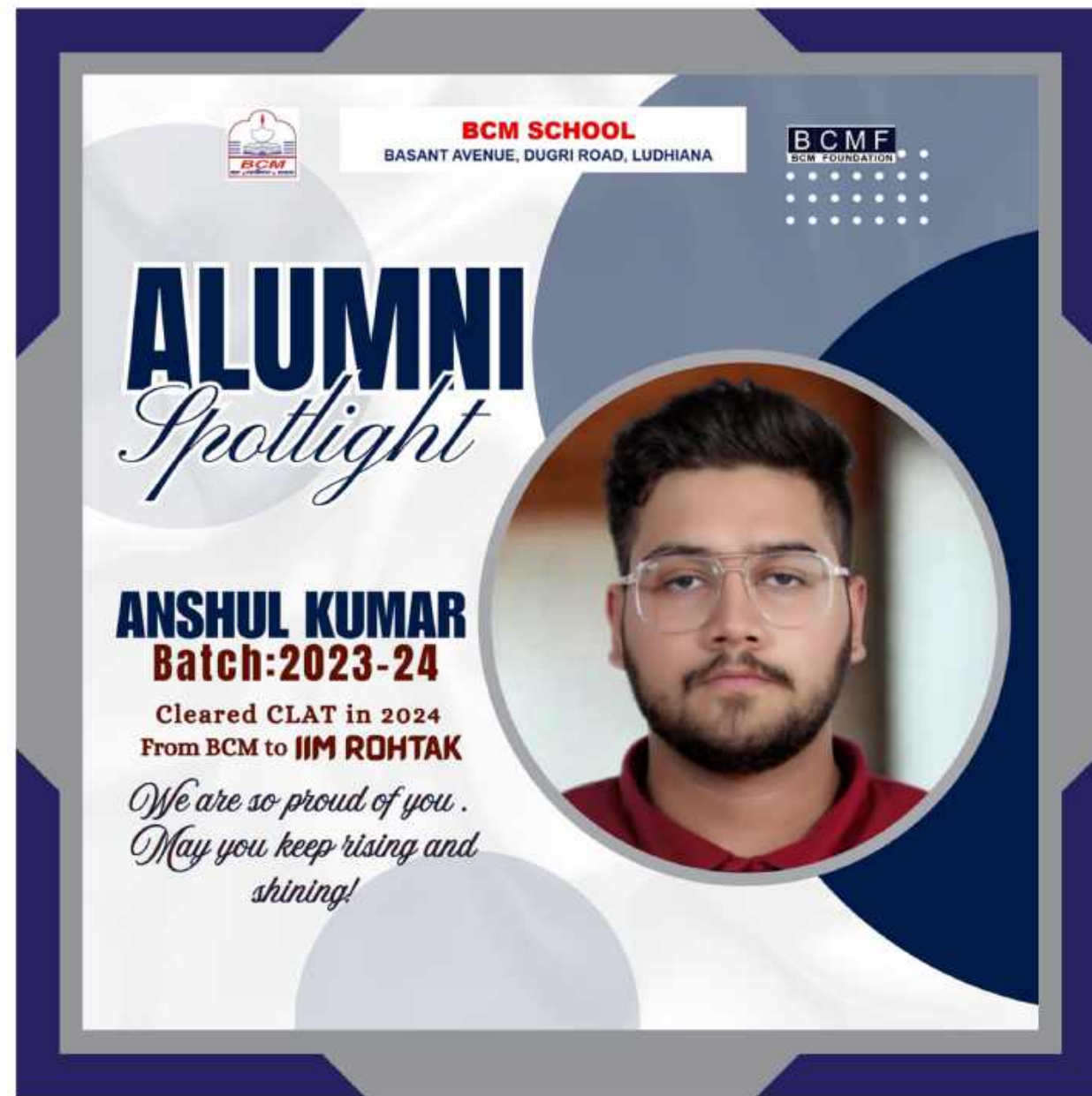

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HONOURING FREEDOM, EMBRACING UNITY: INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS



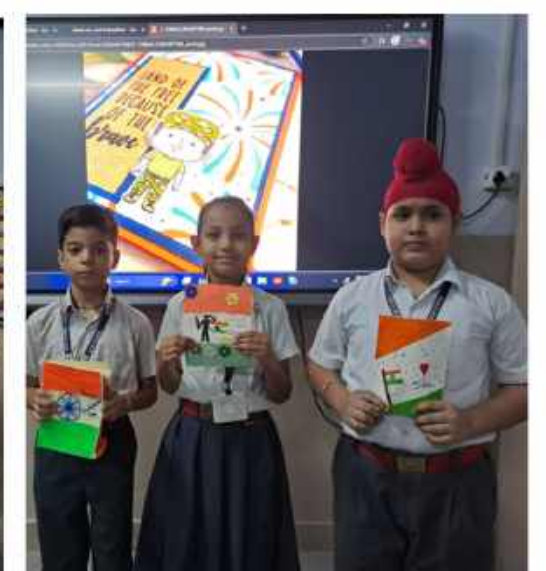

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SILENT WHEELS, STRONG IMPACT



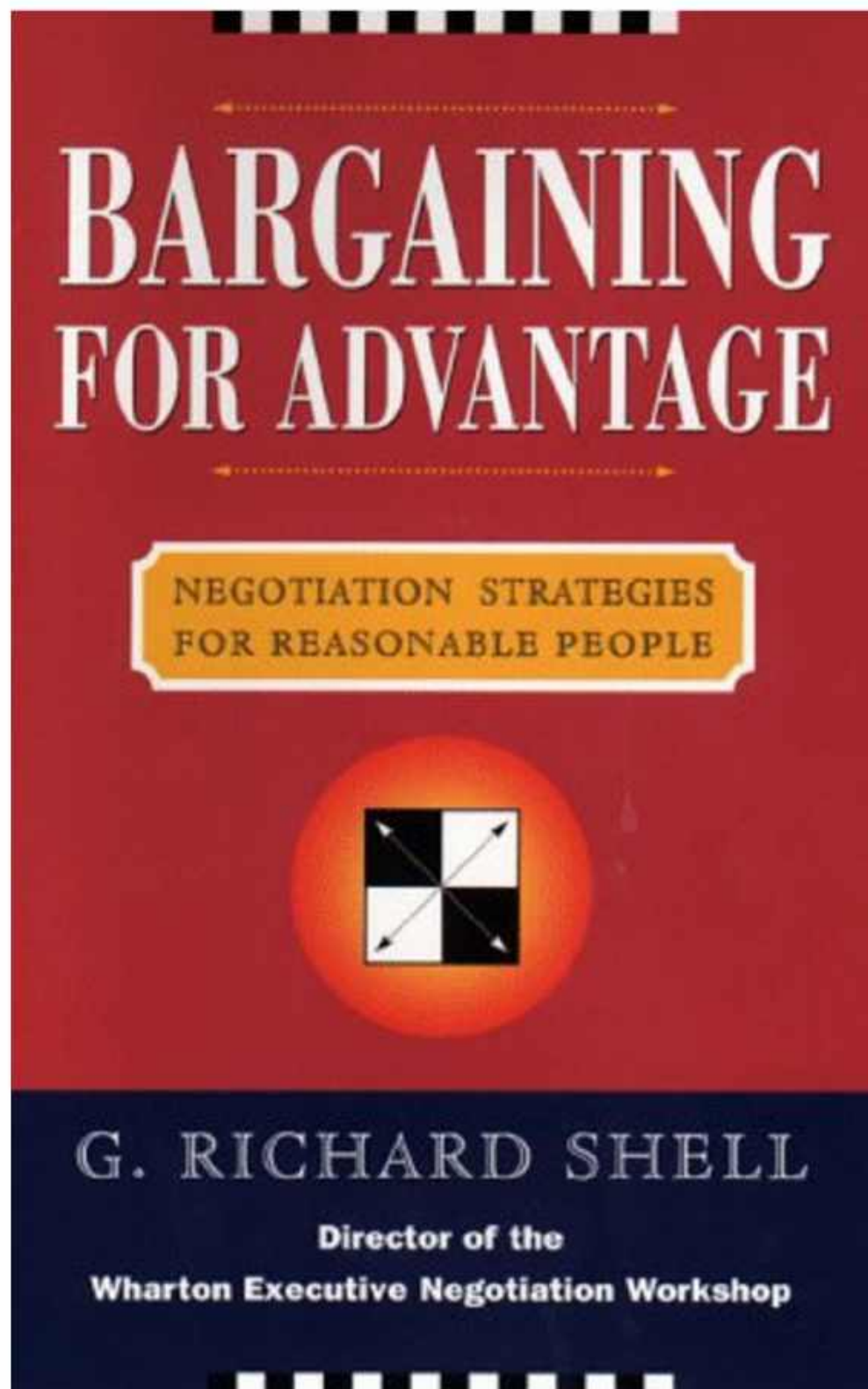

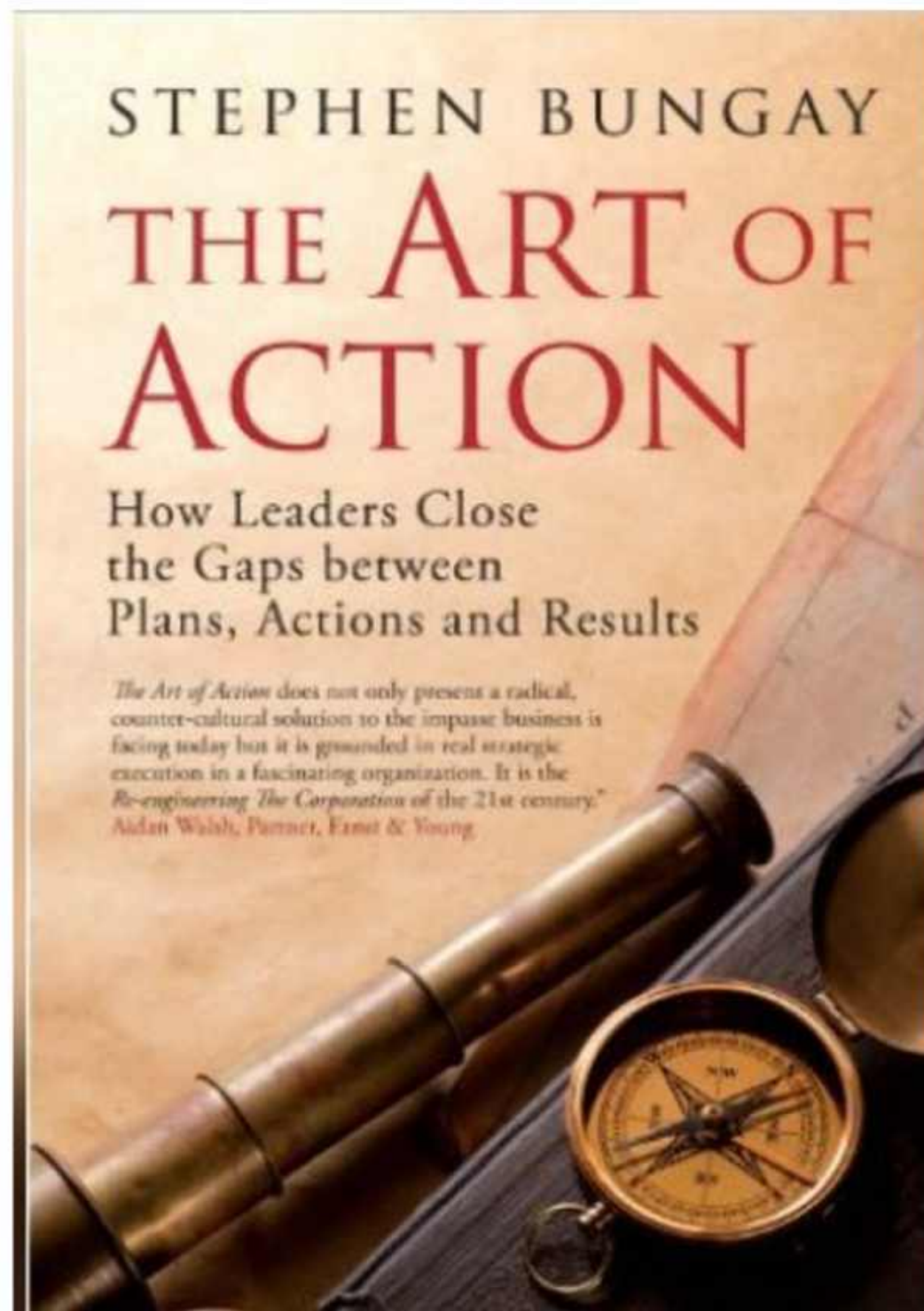
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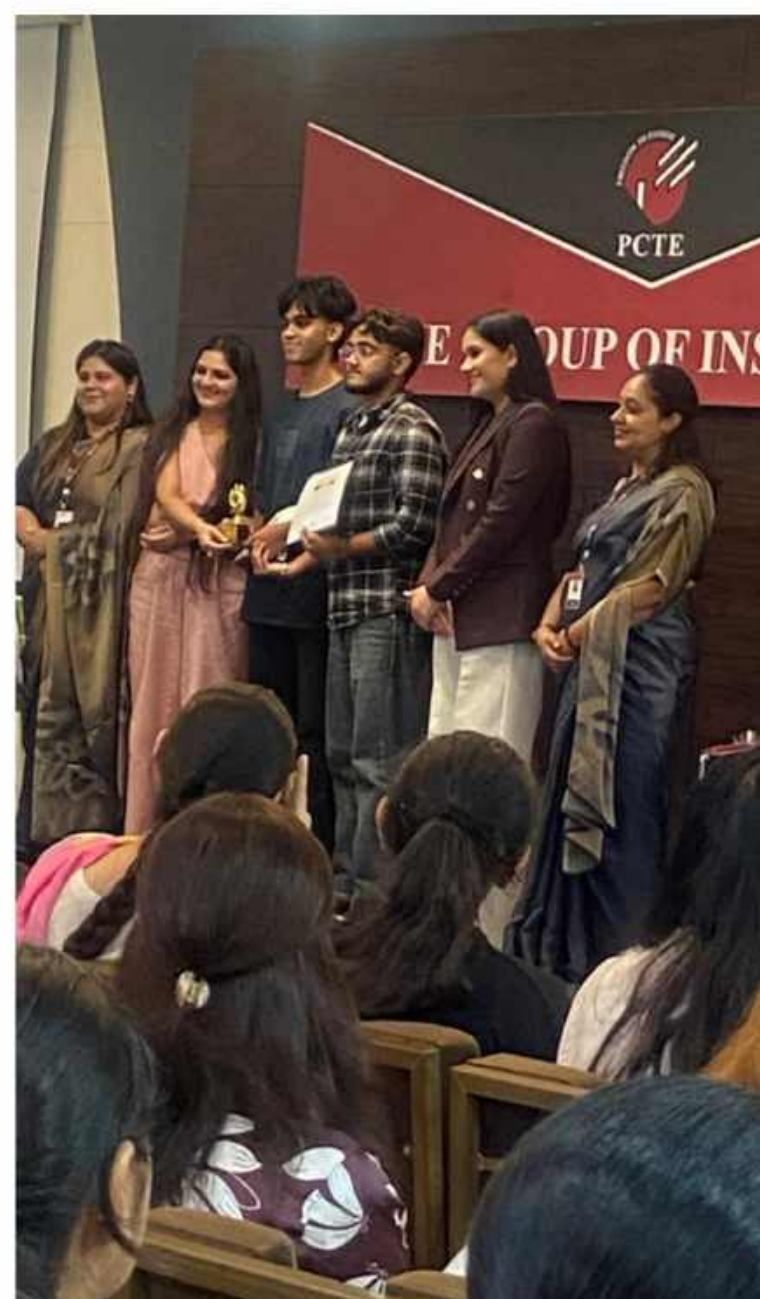
BOOK RECOMMENDATION : **'THE ART OF ACTION'**

‘Stop the burn, start the turn – from smoke to sustainable energy!’

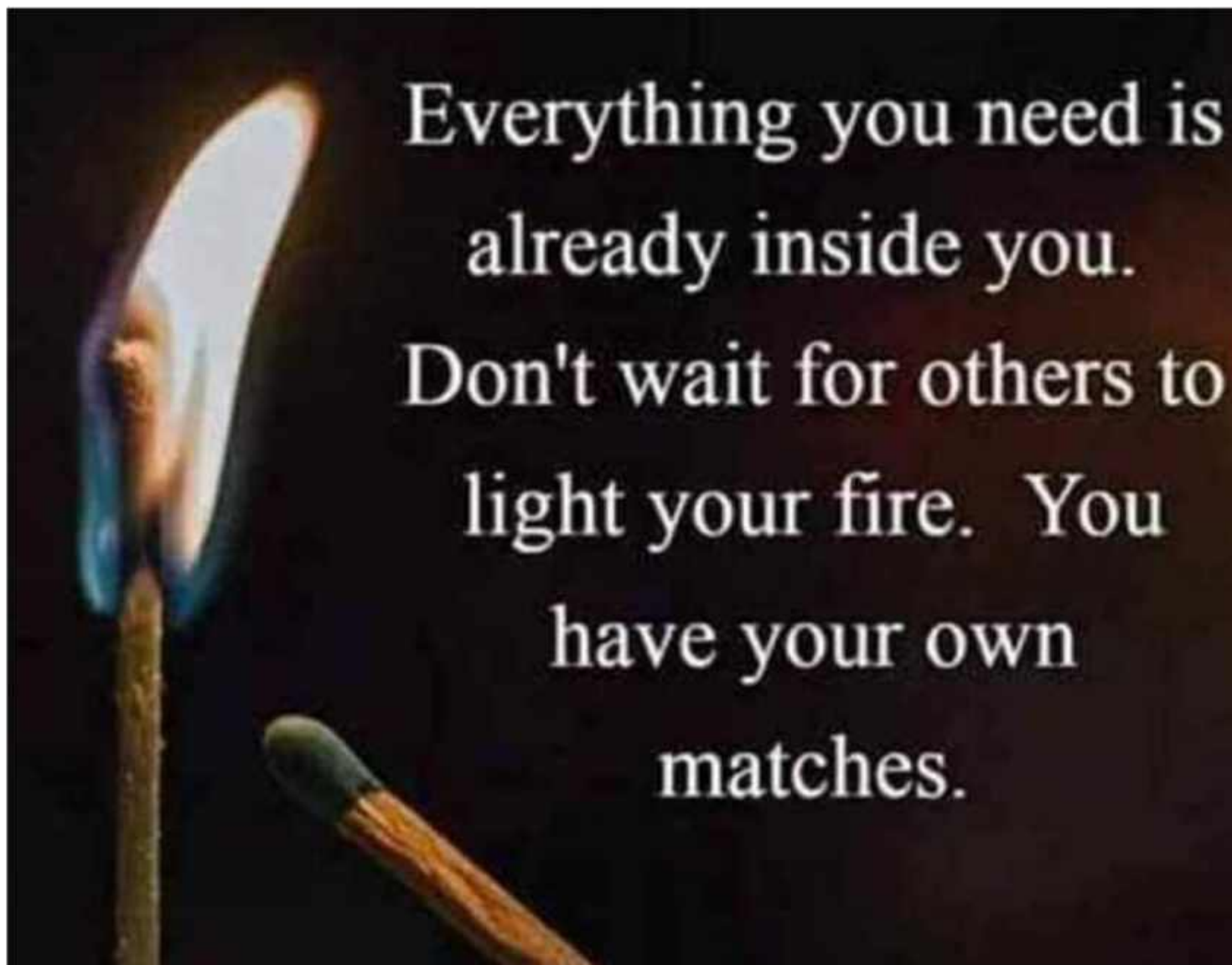

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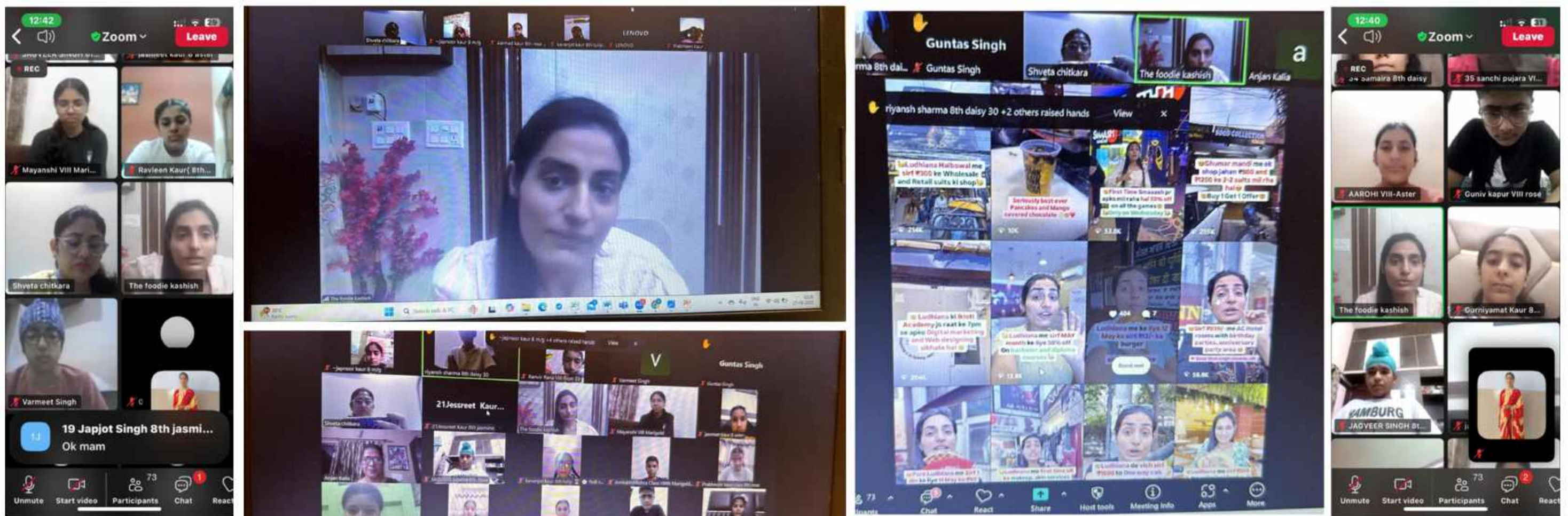
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INDOOR GAMES GALORE: CLASS I STUDENTS CELEBRATE NATIONAL SPORTS DAY
