5. Water does not come out from the glass tumbler. Water in the air deposits on the outer surface of the glass tumbler. This is due to condensation.
6. The normal range of human body temperature is around  $37.0\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$  but can vary slightly due to factors like age, time of day, and activity level. A perfectly healthy person's temperature might be a bit higher or lower than  $37.0\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ .
7. No, we cannot fill 600 mL of water in a bottle labelled as capacity of 500 mL because bottle has only volume to fill 500 mL and extra 100 mL of water gets spilled off the bottle.
8. Water from the surface of utensils evaporates with time.
