Irrespective of their former creed, caste or gender, his followers ate together in the common kitchen (langar). The sacred space created by Guru Nanak Dev Ji was known as Dharmsal. It is now known as Gurudwara. Before his death in 1539, Guru Nanak appointed one of his followers as his successor. His name was Lehna but he came to be known as Guru Angad. It signified that he was a part of Guru Nanak himself.
