Ans- I would discuss the problem with parents and teachers, write a letter to our MLA explaining the issue and request him to raise it in the State Legislative Assembly. I could also raise awareness through school meetings or local campaigns.

Que8- Rahul observed that his community's river water had become contaminated due to industrial waste and sewage. What could be the potential health risks associated with this contamination?

Answer- The potential health risks associated with contaminated river water include waterborne diseases such as cholera, typhoid and dysentery, which can be caused by bacteria, viruses or other pathogens present in the water.
