Objective Type Questions (1 mark each)

Q1. Define *innovation* in the context of entrepreneurship. **Answer:** Innovation in entrepreneurship means introducing new ideas, products, services, or processes that create value and solve problems in unique ways.

Q4. Differentiate between *creativity* and *innovation* in entrepreneurship.

Answer:

- Creativity is the ability to generate new and imaginative ideas.
- Innovation is the practical application of those creative ideas into useful products, services, or processes.
 For example, imagining a solar-powered car is creativity; designing and selling it is innovation.

- 6. **Evaluate Results** Check outcomes and improve further.
