- e. Who would sleep before everyone else?

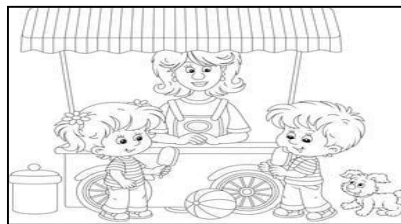
Timmy sleeps before everyone else.

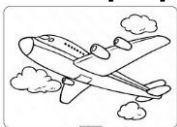

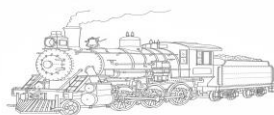

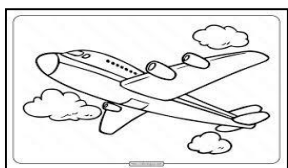
