1.Which is the longest latitude?

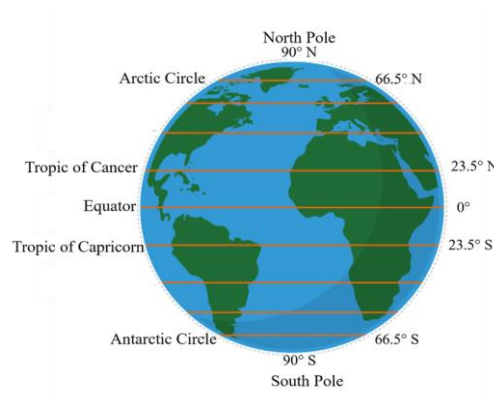
Ans. Equator is the longest Latitude.

So when it is 10:30 am on January 10 in New Zealand, it is 10:30 pm on January 9 in Greenwich. So the cricket match will be telecasted from 10:30 pm on January 9 in Greenwich.
