1. Kharif crops require a lot of water. In the Kharif season, the rain provides this water, and the crops get enough water for their growth. So, Kharif crops cannot be grown in the rabi season as they require ample water for their growth.
2. Ploughing, levelling, and manuring are the three steps of soil preparation.
3. Continuous plantation of crops makes the soil poorer in certain nutrients as the crops take up nutrients from the soil. The soil becomes infertile. It does not get enough time to replenish the nutrients.
4. The microbes grow in a moist environment. Hence, moisture elimination by drying is necessary before storing the grains.
5. CNG stands for Compressed Natural Gas. It is considered to be a better fuel because it is less polluting.
6. Petroleum was formed from organisms living in the sea. As these organisms died, their bodies settled at the bottom of the sea and got covered with layers of sand and clay. Over millions of years, the absence of air, high temperature, and high pressure transformed the dead organisms into petroleum.
