6. How do you classify ocean movements?

Ans. The movements that occur in oceans can be broadly categorized as waves, tides and currents.

1. Waves: When the water on the surface of the ocean rises and falls alternately, they are called waves. During a storm, winds blowing at a very high speed form huge waves and may cause tremendous destruction.

2. Tide: The rhythmic rise and fall of ocean water twice a day is called a tide. It is a high tide when water covers much of the shore by rising to its highest level. It is a low tide when water falls to its lowest level and recedes from the shore.

3. Ocean currents: Ocean Currents are streams of water flowing constantly on the ocean surface in definite directions which may be warm or cold ocean currents. The warm ocean currents originates near the equator and move towards the poles. Whereas the cold ocean currents carry water from polar or higher latitudes to tropical or lower latitudes.
