इसलिए तो शिक्षक भगवान का ही एक अंश कहलाता है।

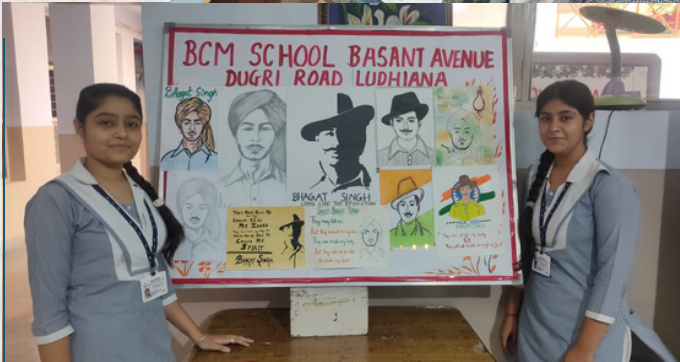
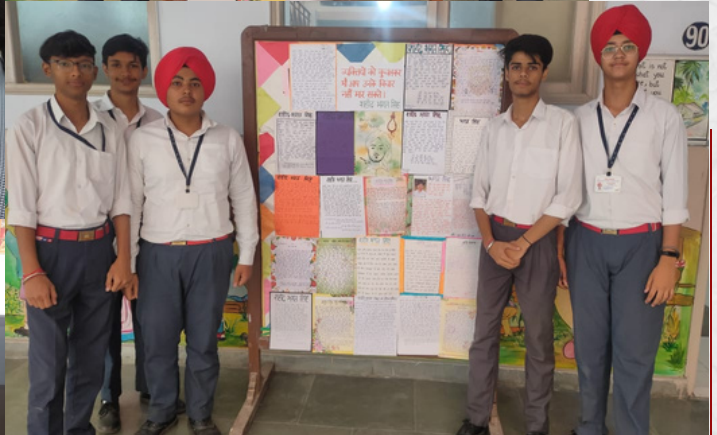
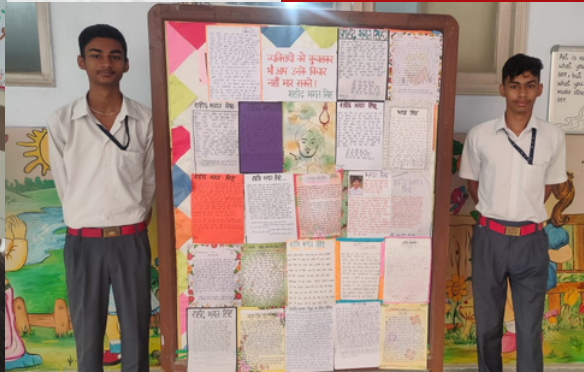

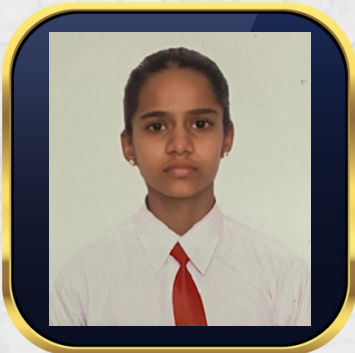


Everyone has the fire, but the champions know when to ignite the spark.

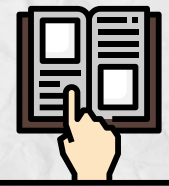
Multimedia Animation

Multimedia Animation is not exactly like animation, but a lot more. Movies like the Civil War, Avengers, Justice League all are the blessings of the multimedia animation industry which an entire family can enjoy together. You may have observed with the way characters were designed, the message that each character carries, comedy, action etc. All these things are possible only through a 'miracle' called and Animation. Those who want to create magic through their skills, career as an Animator is the best option.

A multi media job could be described as the activity of giving life to a non-living object. Multimedia animation is an illusion developed with the still photographs. Multimedia animators work in a specific medium. Some concentrate on making video games or animated movies. Multi media artists produce visual effects for films and television shows. Multimedia career produce computer-generated images that contain representations of the movements of an actor and then animating them into three-dimensional objects. Multi media artists draw beautiful landscapes or backgrounds.

To get into this career students need a degree in Multimedia. They can choose prestigious institutes to get admission through entrance exams like CEED, NID DAT etc.

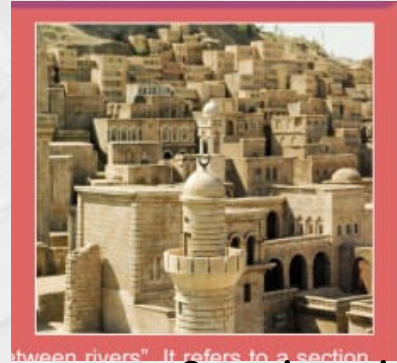

Mesopotamia -Cradle of Civilisation!

Mesopotamia" means "the land between rivers". It refers to a section of land around the Tigris and Euphrates Rivers. Mesopotamia is often called the 'Cradle of Civilisation'. This means it was where human civilisation (with writing, technology and cities) first started.

Mesopotamia was home to many ancient cultures. Firstly, the Sumerians. They invented writing and the system of government. Sumerian writing, government, and culture would make it easier for future civilisations to develop. Then, the Akkadians came. They formed the first united empire. Their language replaced the Sumerian language during their time. After that, the Babylonians came. 'Babylon' means 'Gate of God' or 'Gate of the Gods'. Babylon became the most powerful city in Mesopotamia. Thereafter, the Assyrians occupied Mesopotamia.

At last, the Persians came. The Persians put an end to the rule of the Assyrians and the Babylonians. They conquered much of the Middle East including Mesopotamia.
