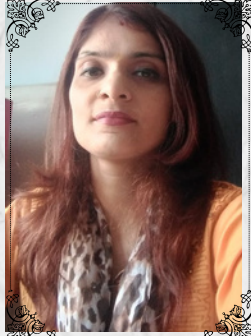

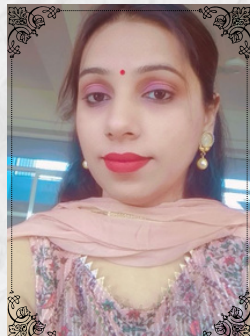

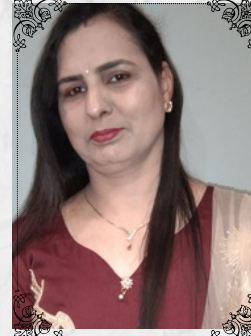

**Shehan Karunatilaka is the 2022 Booker prize winner!**



The *Seven Moons of Maali Almeida*, by Sri Lankan author Shehan Karunatilaka, won the 2022 Booker Prize. This is the second book by Shehan. The main focus of this book is the murder of a war photographer in Colombo in the 1990s. In the middle of a civil war in Sri Lanka, the book also talks about life after death. The Booker Prize is a prestigious literary award given every year to the author of the best English-language novel published in Ireland or the UK. During his acceptance speech, Karunatilaka talked about how it was an honour and a privilege to be on the shortlist with the other winners. Karunatilaka was born in Sri Lanka and grew up in the city of Colombo. He is now officially the second author from that country to win this prize. He completed his education in New Zealand and worked in London, Amsterdam, and Singapore.
